Decision (Action Agreed)	That: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1) the disabled parking facilities in the Market Street car park be reviewed and easier access spaces be provided; 2) Norfolk County Council, as the Highways Authority, be requested to undertake an assessment to consider using the land opposite the old sixth form centre as a dedicated taxi rank; 3) Norfolk County Council be requested to produce new.
