Additional Conditions

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence.
2. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
3. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
4. If during the opening hours of the premises individuals are at the premises to carry out a security activity, each individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

1. Where glass bottles are used they will be retained or disposed of on the premises and no customers will be admitted or permitted to leave when carrying open bottles or glasses.
2. It will be ensured that the consumption of alcohol will be restricted to the areas identified on the plan attached.
3. It will be ensured that any person selling or supplying alcohol within the premises asks the purchaser for a photo ID proof of age where there may be reason to suspect the individual may be under 18 years of age.
4. Any policy requested by the Police and / or Local Authority for preventing the use of prohibitive substances will be adopted.
5. There will be displayed on or immediately outside the premises a notice advising as to the restriction on the age required of individuals to purchase alcohol.
6. The outside lighting presently existing on the premises will be kept on during the hours of darkness in order to provide lighting on the pavement immediately adjoining the premises and in the car park.
7. All escape routes and exits including external exits will be maintained to ensure that they are not obstructed, in good order with non-slippery and even surfaces and will be free of trip hazards. They will be clearly identified.
8. All moveable chairs and tables and internal furnishings will be placed in such a way as to keep free all escape routes and exits and internal gangways.
9. Notices will be displayed on the premises detailing what action is to be taken in the event of fire or other emergencies and access for emergency vehicles will always be kept clear and free from obstruction.
10. Adequate and appropriate supplies of first aid equipment materials will always be available on the premises.

11. Fire safety signs will be kept adequately illuminated and no emergency lighting will be altered without prior notification to the Licensing Authority.
 12. Regular checks and tests will be made to all gas and electrical equipment utilised on the premises.
 13. A valid Public Liability Insurance will always be maintained and a copy of the Schedule will always be available for inspection by an authorised officer on request.
 14. The beer garden will be regularly cleared of empty bottles and glasses.
 15. In the event of there being undue noise on the premises, all doors and windows will be kept closed in order to reduce any noise nuisance from the premises.
 16. A clear and legible notice will be displayed close to exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
 17. Old and empty bottles will only be placed in receptacles outside the premises at times that will minimise disturbance to nearby properties.
 18. All receptacles for waste will be emptied on a regular basis in order to minimise any nuisance from smells.
 19. All litter will be regularly cleared from the vicinity of the premises.
 20. Any Crime Prevention Policy agreed by the Police and the Local Authority will be followed insofar as it relates to the premises.
 21. A Proof of Age policy will be followed.
 22. No children will be permitted in the bar area of the premises except in the case of pre-booked private parties taking place on the first floor of the premises when children may be present in any first floor bar area.
 23. Children will not be permitted on the premises for eating purposes unless they are accompanied by an adult other than children attending a pre-booked private party taking place on the first floor of the premises.
 24. Door staff will be used at the premises on Friday and Saturday evenings.
 25. CCTV will be in operation at the premises.
 26. No unaccompanied children will be allowed on the premises save for children attending a pre-booked private party taking place on the first floor of the premises.
 27. No children will be permitted on the premises after 20:00 hours on Fridays and Saturdays save for children attending a pre-booked private party taking place on the first floor of the premises.
- Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

1. A tamper proof noise limiter will be installed by 4 November 2006.
2. The noise limiter is to be set at a level approved by Breckland Councils Environmental Health Officer.
3. An acoustic consultant will be appointed by 4 November 2006 to produce a report which shall be

submitted to the Councils Environmental Health Officer.

4. The applicant will abide by the findings of the acoustic consultants report.
5. The doors and windows will be kept shut during the provision of regulated entertainment (except for access and egress).
6. On days when the premises are to be used solely for youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) conditions 22, 23 and 26 will not apply.
7. When youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) take place all persons engaged in any role during the event and all members of staff present must be in possession of a valid and current enhanced Criminal Records Bureau check certificate. It will be the responsibility of the premises licence holder to ensure that those persons are in possession of the certificates and will keep records accordingly.
8. When youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) take place there will be at least two properly registered members of door staff on duty at all times one male and one female.
9. When youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) take place notices will be displayed at the entrance to the premises to the effect that nobody (save for staff members or others involved in a supervisory function) aged 18 years or over will be admitted to that part of the venue.
10. When youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) take place door staff will operate a random search policy in an effort to prevent alcohol from being taken into the premises. This policy will be conditional in that if any person refuses to submit to a search they will be denied entry. Notices regarding this search policy must be clearly and obviously displayed at the entrance to the premises. A record of all persons refused entry will be maintained by door staff.
11. When youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) take place door staff will refuse entry to the premises to anyone they suspect may be under the influence of alcohol or any other illegal substances. A record of all such refusals will be maintained by door staff.
12. All alcohol shall be removed from those parts of the premises to which the youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) have access. Furthermore all evidence of alcohol e.g. bar taps shall be concealed.
13. All youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) shall be ticketed in advance for children between the ages of 11 to 17 subject to the maximum attendance permitted under fire regulations.
14. Hours of operation for youth events (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors) will be 10:00 hours to 23:30 hours.
15. The premises shall close at midnight following a youth event (a youth event means all those attending are 17 years of age or under other than supervisors).
16. During pre-booked private parties there will be a minimum of four adults present of mixed gender to supervise those present under 18. Their supervision duties will include supervision of the WC's.

17. During pre-booked private parties there will be a SIA registered member of door staff present at the bottom of the stairs to the first floor to ensure access is supervised.
