I am writing to offer my support in regards to the above application, as a local resident and neighbour of the Sports Centre.

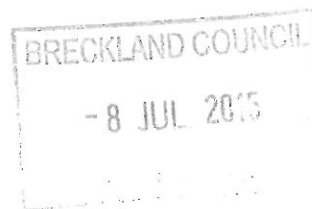

I am writing to express my concern that there has been some opposition to the licence application by Mrs Savage, Watton Sports Centre Manager which, I believe contains a change of timings necessary to facilitate the need for occasional extended opening hours but most definitely not meant to mean extended hours on a regular basis.

To me, as a member of the Sports Centre based Rugby Club, the Sports Centre is a vital facility for the people of Watton and is building steadily on its reputation.

My main concern is that the bulk of the objections do appear to be based partly on a personal vendetta. The complainant has, I believe been canvassing the local (and not so local) residents and has been distributing pre written objection letters which they are asked to signed to be collected.
