<b>Decision</b>	
<p>That having considered all the oral and written evidence submitted and having given consideration to the Licensing Act 2003 and its regulations, the national guidance and the Council's licensing policy, the application be granted for a premises licence for the premises known as Snetterton Race Circuit, Attleborough to operate during the hours as stated below and subject to the mandatory conditions drawn from the Licensing Act and the following conditions:</p> <p>(i) Licensable activity shall be confined to persons attending a pre-arranged and pre-booked event at the premises.</p> <p>(ii) All activity taking place in marquees or other temporary structures shall be deemed to be activity taking place outside.</p> <p>(iii) The Licence Holder shall, from time to time, agree with the Licensing Authority an event risk management document which will be complied with at all times.</p> <p>(iv) In relation to regulated licensed entertainment as defined by the Licensing Act 2003 any noise generated from such entertainment by new or existing PA systems or similar amplified systems should not be clearly audible beyond the freehold site boundary. For clarity, for the hours between 18:30 hrs and 09:00 hrs the noise levels generated by regulated licensed entertainment as described above measured as an equivalent continuous noise level over 5 minutes (Leq, dBA) shall not exceed 5 dBA above the background noise level. The background noise level shall be determined as the level exceeded 90% of the time over a 5 minute period (L90dB(A)). The Council and the applicant shall agree appropriate measurement positions and background noise levels within 60 days of the licence being granted.</p>	

- (v) In respect of all large events at the premises (to be defined as events which the Licence Holder reasonably believes that will be attended by more than 6,000 people)
- (a) the Licence Holder shall give the Norfolk Constabulary and the Licensing Authority no less than 28 days notice of the event;
  - (b) the Licence Holder will agree with the Norfolk Constabulary a drugs policy and a crowd control policy;
  - (c) the Licence Holder will prepare risk assessments for each such event and will give the Fire Authority no less than 28 days notice of any changes in such risk assessments; and
  - (d) the Licence Holder will prepare and adhere to a traffic management policy to the satisfaction of the Norfolk Constabulary.
- (vi) Marquees and other temporary structures within the licensed area shall be situated so as to reduce as far as possible the impact of events upon the local community.

**Reason for the Decision**

Having heard and considered the arguments from both applicant and the interested parties the Sub-Committee have been at pains to reach a decision which would allow the applicant as much flexibility of operation as possible whilst at the same time protecting local residents as much as possible from noise and disturbance.

We have considered specifically whether or not to impose a condition on the Licence requiring the installation of noise limitors but have come to the conclusion that this would not be practicable because of the multiplicity of different sound systems which will no doubt be used for outdoor events. We do however believe that condition (iv) is sufficient to deal with the possibility of noise nuisance.
