

STANDING ORDER NO.21

Delegation of Executive Functions

1. The Leader of the Council shall have the power to determine any delegations to Cabinet, Executive Members and officers of Executive functions. The delegations and the procedures relating to them shall be included in the Constitution.
2. The Leader of the Council shall have the power to appoint up to eight Executive Members, or up to seven Executive Members if a Deputy Leader has been appointed under Standing Order 20. Any of these appointments or changes will become effective on receipt of formal notification in writing by the Chief Executive.
3. Appointment as an Executive Member will automatically debar that member from sitting on any Scrutiny Committees or Scrutiny Panels.

STANDING ORDER NO.32

Constitution and Terms of Reference of Committees

The following Committees shall be the Standing Committees of the Council and shall consist of the number of members (exclusive of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Council) specified opposite each Committee, and shall be subject to their Terms of Reference as approved by the Council:-

Appeals Committee	6 Members
Audit Committee	5 Members
Development Control Committee	19 Members
General Purposes Committee	12 Members
Licensing Committee	12 Members
Overview and Scrutiny Commission	16 Members
Standards Committee	9 Members
Staffing Panel	9 Members
