NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

The Breckland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Breckland District Council (“the Council”), in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and all other enabling powers, proposes to make the Breckland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2019 (“the Amending Order”).

The effect of the Amending Order, if made, will be to amend the Breckland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2014 so as to restrict vehicles other than electric vehicles from parking in electric vehicle charging bays, and to require electric vehicles to move out of electric vehicle charging bays once they have been charged. The amendments are required because the Council:

(a) proposes to introduce electric vehicles charging bays at the following car parks:

- Cowper Road Dereham,
- St Nicholas Street Thetford,
- Queens Square Attleborough
- Pedlars off Market Place Swaffham

(b) may wish to enforce against the incorrect use of the electric vehicle parking bays

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Amending Order which, together with a statement of the Council’s reason for proposing to make the Amending Order, may be examined at the Council’s Offices at Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, Dereham Norfolk, NR19 1EE during normal office hours.
